

The People's Church Partington Sermon Series: Discipleship Basics Study Guide #4 – Doing what Jesus did

1. Read Luke 4.14-19. What was Jesus called to do?

Here is a basic pattern of what it means to be an apprentice:

I do; you watch I do; you help You do; I help You do; I watch

- How did Jesus follow this pattern with his disciples from what you know of the Gospels? (eg Luke 8.1-3; Luke 9.1-6; Luke 10.1-2, 17; Matthew 17.14-20; Matthew 28.18-20)
- 3. Who have you been an apprentice under (apart from Jesus) as a Christian who has helped you learn to do what Jesus does?
- 4. **Read John 14.12-14**. What is your reaction to Jesus saying "anyone who believes in me will do the same works I have done, and even greater works..."?
- 5. Jesus says, "ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it!" what do you have faith to ask for right now? What do you need more faith for?
- WWJDIHWM? John Mark Comer suggests asking the question "What Would Jesus Do If He Were Me?" Think of something significant in your life right now – family, work, relationships, church – what do you think the answer to WWJDIHWM is for that area of your life?
